Purpose

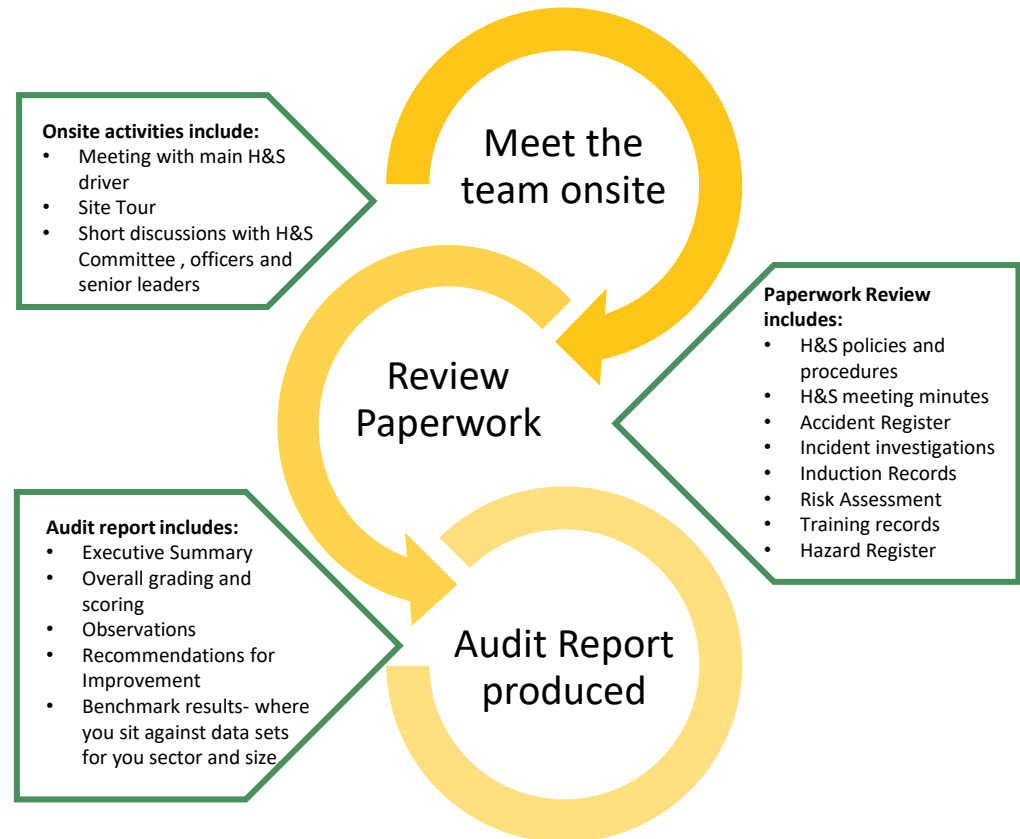
- The Audit will provide an in-depth review of your organisations Health and Safety system and culture.
